- Co-financed by the Egyptian Ministry of Higher Education and the DAAD
- For PhD-candidates:
 - **Full PhD:** PhD awarded by a German university (up to 42 months)
 - **Channel:** PhD awarded by an Egyptian university (up to 24 months)

German-Egyptian Research Short Term Scholarship Program (GERSS)

Eligibility

- Age limit:
Graduates: 26 years
Medicine graduates: 29 years
PhD candidates: 36 years
Post doc candidates: 40 years
- Affiliation to a private or public Egyptian university and/or research institute.

Requirements

- Application forms (online, general and proposal)
- Acceptance letter from a German professor
- Endorsement letter from the Egyptian university/institute
- Statement of employment history (بيان حالة)

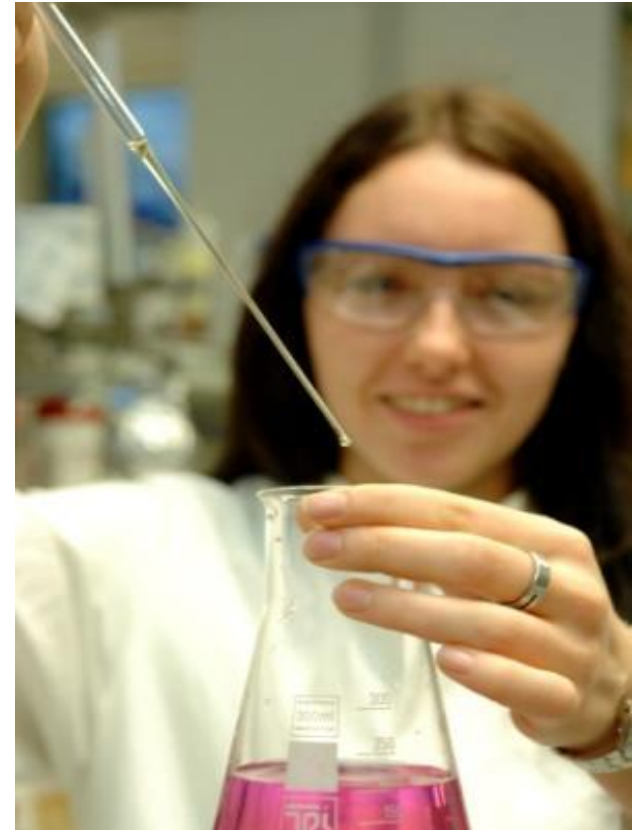

- Deadline: 15th February (~15 scholarships per call)

- For study programs leading to a final qualification
 - Information about preferred program
 - If applicable: letter of acceptance from the host university
- For further training that does not lead to a final qualification
 - Confirmation of supervision from a German university teacher

Requirements

- A precise identical project proposal submitted by the Egyptian PI to the STDF www.stdf.org.eg and by the German PI to DAAD Bonn www.daad.de

Eligibility

- The PI should be a PhD holder
- Involvement of young scientists
- All relevant documents as ethical committee approval.

Eligibility

- German-Egyptian research teams from public or private Egyptian and German research organizations, HE institutions, SMEs non-governmental or civil society organizations
- The Principal Investigator (PI) on the Egyptian side must hold a PhD, affiliated to an institution with Egyptian legal identity.

Requirements

- Registration on the STDF website (<http://www.stdf.org.eg/>)
- Full project proposal
- Structured financing plan
- Time schedule and milestones

■ Program Goal

- Max. fund 100.000 €/ year.
